These Championships were first held 43 years ago, at Eridge in Great Britain in 1967 when only 10 riders competed including seven from the host nation and three from France. The number of participants has grown enormously over the intervening years and the Championships have provided an important stepping-stone in the careers of many stars of the sport. Britain's Virginia Holgate took Junior individual gold at Pompadour in France in 1973 before going on to success at Olympic, World and European level and on her way to becoming a five-time Burghley and three-time Badminton champion.
